Donnie Bradham won \$60 for low net in A Flight on the back nine with a 33. Dan VanWert won back nine low net in B Flight with a net 30 and Mike Linares won low net back nine in C Flight with a 31. Dan and Mike both won \$60.

For the full round, Matt Schapman won \$140 for taking first place in A Flight with a net 69. Scott Fritts won B Flight honors with a net

63. And Mike Linares won C Flight with a net 63. Scott and Mike also won \$140 each.

Ron Boone won second place for A Flight in the overall low net with a 69. Dan VanWert won second place low net for B Flight with a 66 and Darren Howard won second place for C Flight with a net 71. All three won \$100 each.

Donnie Bradham won third place for A Flight in the full round low net by shooting 71. Hershel Krigbaum won B Flight with a net 66 and Alexis Cliburn won for C Flight with a net 71. All three earned \$80 each.

For the first time in ITG history, trophies were awarded for the lowest gross scores in each flight. Donnie Bradham shot a 71 to win A Flight honors. Scott Fritts shot a 79 to win B Flight honors and Mike Linares shot 86 to win for C Flight.
